

# Canadian Gambling Digest 2008-2009: Addendum

The following are updates to the 2008-09 *Canadian Gambling Digest*:

**Page 2: Table 1. Venues**

Nova Scotia: The number of *Bars and Lounges with VLTs* was 408 (the 368 reported did not include the 40 VLT sites on First Nations reserves). *Total Venues 2008-09* was 1,602 (not 1,562).

Canada: *Total Venues 2008-09* for the country overall was 36,612 (not 36,572).

**Page 3: Table 2. Games**

Nova Scotia: The number of *VLTs at Bars and Lounges* was 2,819 (the 2,234 reported did not include the 585 VLTs on First Nations reserves). *Total Games 2008-09* was 3,811 (not 3,226).

Canada: *Total Games 2008-09* for the country overall was 101,626 (not 101,041).

**Page 4: Table 3. Select Venues and Games per 100,000 People 18+**

Nova Scotia: The number of *EGMs per capita* was 493.2 (not 416.4). The number of *EGM Venues per capita* was 53.8 (not 48.6).

Canada: The average number of *EGMs per capita* across the country was 508.8 (not 501.1). The average number of *EGM Venues per capita* was 52.3 (not 51.8).

**Page 11: Table 8. Net Gaming Revenue to Government**

Manitoba: *Total Revenue 2008-09* was \$416,147,000 (not \$310,892,000).

Prince Edward Island: *Total Revenue 2008-09* was \$28,550,000 (not \$18,283,000).

Canada: *Total Revenue 2008-09* for the country overall was \$7,152,489,000 (not \$7,036,967,000).

**Page 12: Chart 4. Percentage of Provincial Revenue Derived from Gaming**

Manitoba: The percentage of provincial revenue derived from gaming was 3.22 (not 2.41).

Prince Edward Island: The percentage of provincial revenue derived from gaming was 2.07 (not 1.33).

Canada: The average percentage of provincial revenue derived from gaming across the country was 2.45 (not 2.29).

**Page 14: Table 10. Distributions to Charity, Problem Gambling, and Responsible Gaming**

British Columbia: *Total Responsible Gaming 2008-09* was \$2,042,000 (not \$732,000).

Canada: *Total Responsible Gaming 2008-09* for the country overall was \$30,454,000 (not \$29,144,000).

**Page 15: Chart 5. Percentage of Government Gaming Revenue Distributed to Problem Gambling**

Manitoba: The percentage of government gaming revenue distributed to problem gambling was .73 (not .97).

Canada: The average percentage of government gaming revenue distributed to problem gambling across the country was 1.43 (not 1.46).
