# Open Access: Definition

- Literature that is digital, online, free of charge, and free of most copyright and licensing restrictions (Suber, Overview)
- Focus: peer-reviewed journal
- Two approaches: journals and archives
- Gratis (free to read) / Libre (free to reuse)

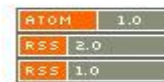

As well as providing a simple [repository list](#), OpenDOAR lets you [search for repositories](#) or [search repository contents](#). Additionally, we provide tools and support to both repository administrators and service providers in sharing best practice and improving the quality of the repository infrastructure. The current directory lists repositories and allows breakdown and selection by a variety of criteria - see the [Find](#) page - which can also be viewed as [statistical charts](#). 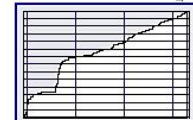
Developments will be of use both to users wishing to find original research papers and for service providers like search engines or alert services which need easy-to-use tools for developing tailored search services to suit specific user communities.

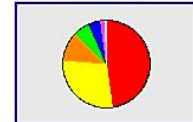

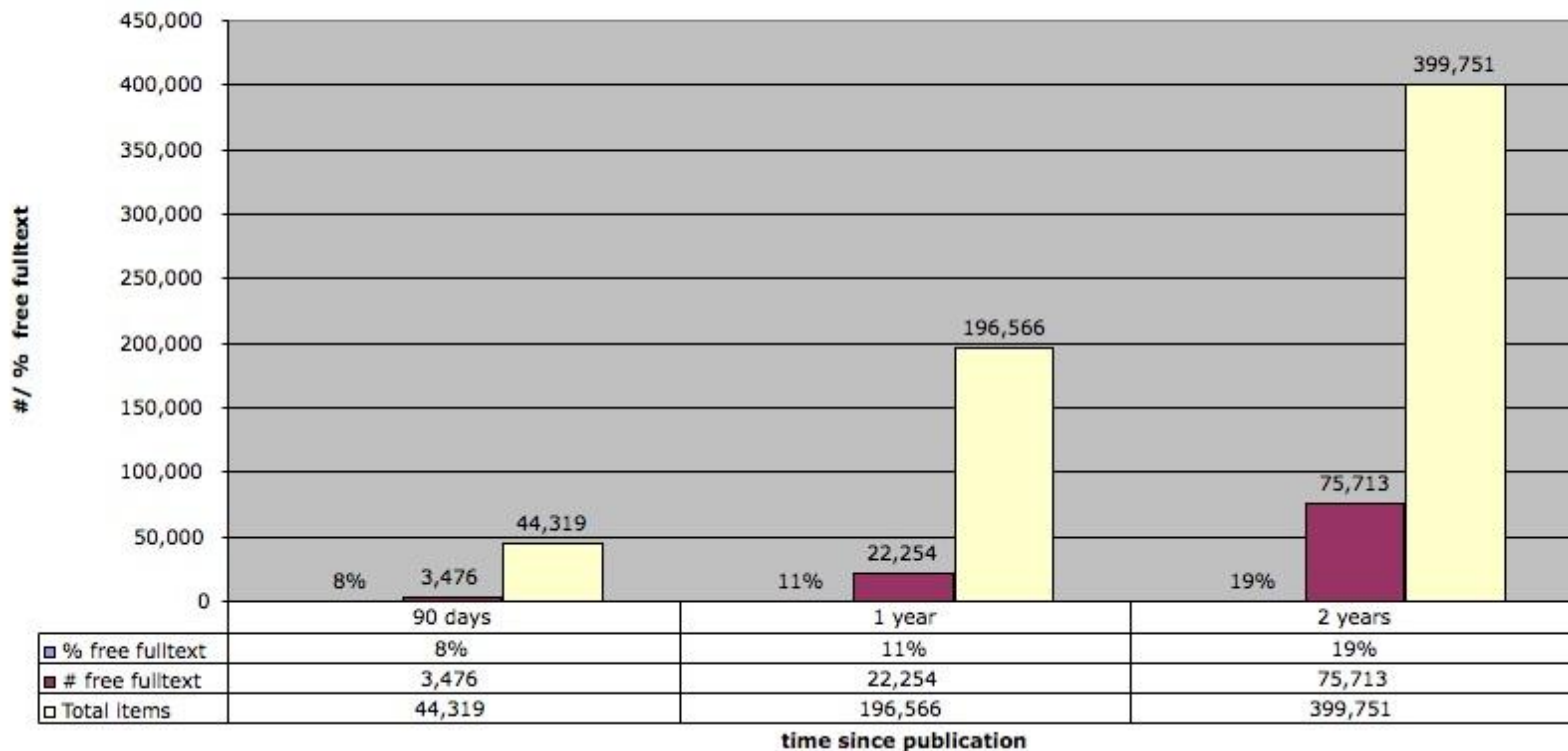

Regrettably, this means that one cannot search for SU(3) or  $c=1$  at this time (but searching for 'c' AND '1' will give hits on 'c = 1').

The good news: The characters ^,\_,.,,+, and - are indexed. For example, searching for K<sup>+</sup> or nu<sub>e</sub> will work - be aware that authors aren't always consistent in how super- and subscripts are presented.

Non-indexed characters are stripped out from the search query.
